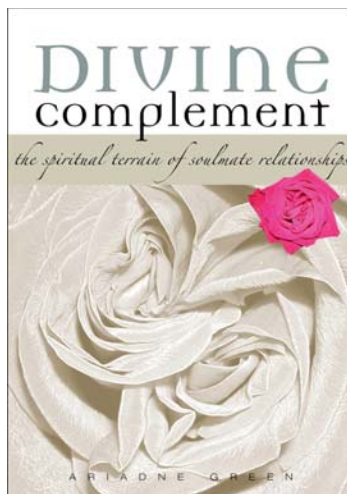

TALKING POINTS

Q. With so many singles online looking for “the ONE,” why is it that we hear so few success stories?

A. Online profiles and capability tests can neither replicate the divine design of complementary traits that a true soul mate possesses, nor orchestrate a meeting in the same meaningful way. It would be nice if a person could Google their twin soul with a few search words, but it’s not likely that they would be entering in the right keywords. Most people are looking for an ideal rather than for their complementary match. It’s not so much about conducting a search for our Divine Complement as much as recognizing them when they come.

Q. When we think of soul mates, are we looking for our Divine Complement?

A. My hope is that Divine Complement will become the new mainstream colloquialism for a soul mate, because it best describes what a “true” soul mate really is. The link between soul mates originates in a divine dimension and comes out of a divine source—God. There certainly is something heavenly and otherworldly about a couple who seem so perfect for each other and who come together in often serendipitous and magical ways—mind-boggling. Our twin complement holds traits that are uniquely and perfectly matched to our own, and because they have a divine spiritual connection to us—hence the term, Divine Complement.

Q. The truth: Were Jesus and Mary Magdalene really twin souls, and where is the evidence?

A. Yes. There is plenty of evidence within the narrative of the Gospels to point to the likelihood of a dynastic marriage. Mary’s devotion and companionship is central to the Gospel story, and there are clues that suggest that the wedding in Cana was Jesus’ own wedding feast. By dispelling the “myths” of Orthodox Christianity about Jesus’ marital status and his redemptive purpose on Earth, we can begin to open up to and embrace a truer story. I discovered a mythological blueprint of Jesus and Mary Magdalene’s mutual destiny—the Hellenistic myth of Adonis and Aphrodite. In the book, I draw important parallels between Jesus and Mary’s lives and the mythological elements of the story of Adonis and his consort, demonstrating how critical the myth is to understanding their real lives, psychological dilemmas, and their unique destiny as twin souls.

Q. What inspired you to include the legacy of Jesus and Mary Magdalene in Divine Complement?

A. With the release of the movie *The Da Vinci Code*, we are witnessing nothing less than a mainstream frenzy—a controversy like no other—with clues to be decoded, further facts to pull out of the embellished Gospel narratives, and unanswered questions yet to be posed. What this all suggests is that there is a profound awakening taking place, catalyzed by a novel that will prove to be more truth than fiction. We seek the truth no matter what the Vatican says. We crave to touch the humanness of Jesus Christ and the divinity of

Mary Magdalene, to know Mary's true legacy rather than a preposterous image of her as sinner. Her spiritual role as Jesus' Divine Complement—his twin—and as disciple offers the promise of raising feminine consciousness as a whole and the spiritual status of women for the future. I pose the following question: Is it possible that if God put “two” in the Garden of Eden, that God would send “two” to raise us from the fall? As twin souls, Jesus and Mary's legacy lights the path of spiritual unity, something I elaborate on in my book.

Q. Why is *Divine Complement* different from every other soul-mate book on the market?

A. Over the last ten years, there have been many noteworthy books on the topic. A few suggest the notion of multiple soul mates (more than one possible soul-mate match), and a couple of others deny that a soul mate even exists. Comprehensive research and interviews of over 200 couples make my book a meaningfully thick and fascinating exploration that should bring most readers to the certainty that Cinderella's slipper was never meant to fit more than one authentic bride.

Q. After reading *Divine Complement*, will people be able to identify a true soul mate?

A. Yes. I would hope that most people would be better prepared for what I call the “reunion” with their twin. I demonstrate how there are always signs along the way and even night dreams that authenticate a Divine Complement. I give many meaningful examples.

Q. For people searching for love, what is the most important message of your book?

A. The quest for love is something I have described as a quest for Divine Consciousness. The love we seek with someone special may be within our reach, and we just haven't recognized them or welcomed them into our lives and into our hearts. That is often the case. Or they are somewhere on the horizon waiting for divine timing to be set. Divine timing may bring that one special person who will coax out the love we have inside and give us the opportunity for a lasting commitment, a way to learn about love over time. Hoping to spark a reader's own insights through reflection and contemplation, I offer 36 Divine Principles scattered throughout the book that evoke spiritual insight. Here's one, for instance:

“Divine Principle: The illumination of God is our ultimate destiny. It is achieved through a transition that sheds the singular life that we hold so meaningful and brings us to a sacred union with the divine.”

Q. Can there be more than one twin soul?

A. Divine Complements have a spirit-to-spirit connection that cannot be replicated by another soul. We can have many possibilities for complementary partnership: those who match us nicely and who will offer us fulfilling possibilities for love and commitment and will ultimately bring us happiness. But there is only one to whom we are eternally bonded spirit-to-spirit through a signature in the heart.

Q. What happens if your Divine Complement sails into the sunset without you or in the case of divorce?

A. It doesn't mean that the connection ends, because Divine Complements continue to share a room in each other's hearts even if they never see each other again in this life. Many couples I interviewed were given a second chance later in life to renew the friendship, and some even made it to the altar after a long journey apart. Life may offer Divine Complements a second chance at love because their souls' deepest yearning is to be together. But in the case where nothing seems to turn the tide and soul mates split up for good, there can be a second chance with someone new.

Q. Is there an unconscious drive and hidden purpose to twin-soul relationships?

A. "To learn about love" is the highest purpose of our lives. And it is what drives us the most. The problem lies in the fact that love is put to the test daily and some fail at the test miserably. There are spiritual, psychological and human lessons to learn in every relationship, and how we approach each lesson will determine how far we evolve. It will also determine how content we become as a couple. The biggest unconscious drive is to balance our intelligence, male and female—something that complementary relationships help us to achieve. One little-talked-about purpose of a soul-mate relationship is that we must redeem ourselves from past-life karma. The times when we failed miserably at fulfilling our promises to our twin must be balanced with loving choices and exchanges in this life.
